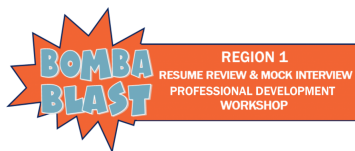

Region 1 Post NILA 2018 Hosted at Google Mountain View

Chapter leaders from across the region joined on site and via Google Hangout to receive useful information and training on how to be successful chapter leaders. Guest Speaker Hugo Castellanos presented a workshop: Empowering Leaders Through Public Speaking - where he shared important tips on how to communicate effectively when presenting.

Chapter Highlights

- Our newest chapter at **University of Alaska Fairbanks (UAF)** was able to attend a Startup Weekend Event where they not only launched a business in 54 hours along side entrepreneurs, but won 1st and 2nd place awards. This also guaranteed their SHPE chapter a position at the UAF Arctic Innovation Competition where they have a chance to win \$10,000 to kickstart their new company. [Read the full story.](#)
- While their semester is just two weeks in, our **UC Santa Cruz** chapter has set up a panel of Electronics Arts engineers to speak to their chapters and give them a tour of their facility.
- **UC Merced's** chapter has gathered 80 students to attend the HENAAC conference, while securing a charter bus for 54 students.
- **UC Berkeley** chapter was able to collaborate with the **SF Bay Area** professional chapter to host a MentorSHPE Mixer where students received advice from professionals through presentations/Q&A panel, and a speed mentoring session. This event was well attended by nearby collegiate chapters and professionals.
- Over 100 collegiate and professional members volunteered at the Latino Engineering day at the Exploratorium hosted by the **San Francisco Bay**

Area Professional Chapter. For this all-day free event, families explored science and engineering at the San Francisco Exploratorium. Workshops on corn diversity for example were led by scientists and engineers, and the event ended with a panel of professionals.

- **Silicon Valley Professional Chapter** hosted Fireside Chat at Cloudera in Palo Alto on September 25th. A chat with Eddie Garcia, recently awarded CISO of the Year 2018. They also hosted a meet a greet BBQ to welcome their members.

K-12 Initiatives

Project 4-2-1

It is one of the main objectives for this year that every SHPE Jr. Chapter completes Project 4-2-1. Project 4-2-1 is a SHPE National program that provides a road map for SHPE Jr. operation. Chapters who complete Project 4-2-1 will receive an prestigious award and SHPE National recognition at the SHPE National Convention.

- **4:** Hands on STEM Activities. One in each of the following areas (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math)
- **2:** MentorSHPE Activities. Activities could include a resume workshop, engineering panel, or personal statement workshop.
- **1:** Get out and STEM. Outreach event is designed to get students out of the classroom and give them a first hand STEM experience. You can go to a museum, tour a local university, or host a Noche de Ciencias.
